This particular application was interesting, as traditionally in security applications, mild steel is used and is powder coated to have a nice, painted finish. In this case, the client requested we use stainless steel for the bullet-resistant/forced-entry doors and windows. The heavy gauges made the manufacturing extraordinarily complex, but the end result was an aesthetically-pleasing end product that met the client's security requirements.
